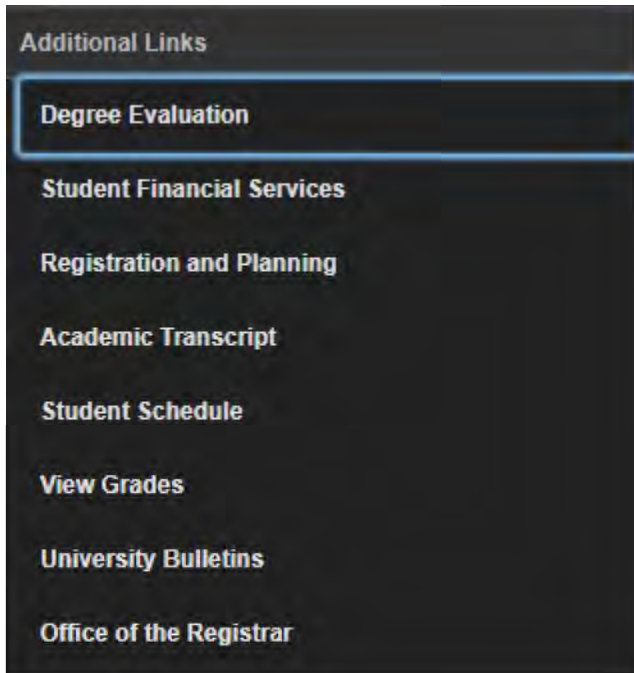


# Running Your Degree Evaluation

# Reading Your Degree Evaluation

First, your degree evaluation will give you information about your total credit hours and cumulative (aka overall) GPA.

The **Total Required** is the number of credit hours you must earn for your degree. Distributive (old) core students must complete 128 credit hours to earn their degree and Integrative (new) core students must complete 120 credit hours to earn their degree. **The Used hours in the Total Required row totals all of the credits that you have completed, transferred in, and are currently registered for.**

The next line, **Last Number Institutional Required**, refers to the graduation requirement that at least 60 semester hours must be completed in residence at JCU.

The next lines show your cumulative **GPA**. All students must earn a 2.0 or higher cumulative GPA to graduate. In-progress credits are also shown here.
